The email exchange below confirms our inability to locate the first volume of ██████████ deposition. However, attached are fairly detailed notes of Paralegal/Investigator Mike Danchuk, who attended the deposition and recorded these notes contemporaneously. ██████████ appears to have held nothing back, and the notes certainly paint a picture of the kind of troubled young women who were particularly susceptible to Epstein's pattern of recruitment, grooming and victimization.
